HOW TO CARE FOR TILE FLOORS

Following are a few simple guidelines that will help you maximize the lifespan of the sealant and keep your floors looking their best.



CLEANING TIPS



VACUUM REGULARLY

Vacuum your tile and grout weekly instead of sweeping. Vacuuming effectively removes particles, both large and small, and is essential before mopping to ensure dirt is not spread around.



USE PH-NEUTRAL CLEANER

If warm water no longer does the trick, use a pH-neutral cleaner. Avoid alkaline or acidic products, as they can damage the sealant. Always rinse thoroughly, even with "No-Rinse" formulas, to prevent any residue from attracting dirt.



MOP WITH WARM WATER

After sealing, mopping with warm water is usually sufficient. If you vacuum regularly, you may only need to mop every 6-10 weeks. For best results, clean up spills by hand whenever possible, and change the water frequently when mopping to avoid spreading dirt.



PROFESSIONAL CLEANING
